Dance Guidelines

1. Rancho dances are for Rancho students only.
2. All school rules apply before, during, and after any dance. You must arrive within 45 minutes of the start of the dance unless prior arrangements are made with an administrator.
3. A ticket is valid only for the student submitting the permission form and purchasing the ticket. There are **NO REFUNDS** and **TICKETS CAN NOT BE TRANSFERRED OR RESOLD**.
4. Students are to remain in the dance area until the dance ends or their parent picks them up.
5. Parents must pick up their students within 20 minutes of the end of a dance. Students loitering on the campus may not be allowed to attend the next dance.
6. An adult with transportation must be available by telephone for students attending dances.
7. Students not attending dances may not be on the school grounds during dances. The Irvine Police Department will be contacted about people loitering on the campus during dances and school disciplinary measures will also be enforced if any loiterers are Rancho students.
8. Appropriate school attire must be worn to all dances. No hats may be brought to the dance.
9. Students are to avoid any unsafe or inappropriate behavior during the dance.
10. Food and drink, including candy and gum, are to be consumed outside in the quad area.
